## MR. & MRS. H. B. CHRISTIE MEMORIAL SCHOALRSHIP

H. B. Christie was born in Amherst in 1904. A lifelong resident of the Town, he graduated from Amherst High School and worked as manager of Dominion Manufacturers factory and as a commercial traveler. He was a devoted outdoorsman who spent his summers, first at the family cottage at Tidnish and after his marriage, at Amherst Shore.

Alice Christie was also born in Amherst, in 1908. Though her family moved to Sussex, New Brunswick shortly afterwards, she spent every summer of her life at Amherst Shore, first at her family cottage and, after her marriage, in the Christie farmhouse. Mrs. Christie graduated from Sussex High School, Dalhousie University, B.A. 1928, and the University of Toronto, M.A 1929. After teaching in private schools in the U.S. she married and moved to Amherst, where she was an active citizen, as a member of the North Nova's Badminton Club where she organized the juniors for many years, the Golf Club, the Curling Club, the Highland View Hospital Ladies Auxiliary and the Children's Aid Society.

Their four children donate this Scholarship in their memory in recognition of their respect and affection for "the Shore" and its residents.
